ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Ensures high risk behaviors of clients are mitigated through therapeutic services, which may include education and skill development of a client's guardian or caregiver.
- Completes an initial comprehensive/diagnostic mental health assessment of clients unless previous assessment is provided.
- Participates in or conducts the individualized treatment plan (person-centered/strength-based plan) and meetings with the multi-disciplinary treatment team.
- Provides weekly individual and family therapy as prescribed in the client's individual treatment plan (person-centered/strength-based plan).
- Provides crisis intervention services and identifying these services in the client's community.
- Ensures payment authorization is submitted timely and accurate to ensure appropriate payment can be processed.
- Provided ongoing data collection and monitoring of client's presenting emotional and mental health issues.
- Maintains assigned productivity requirements.
